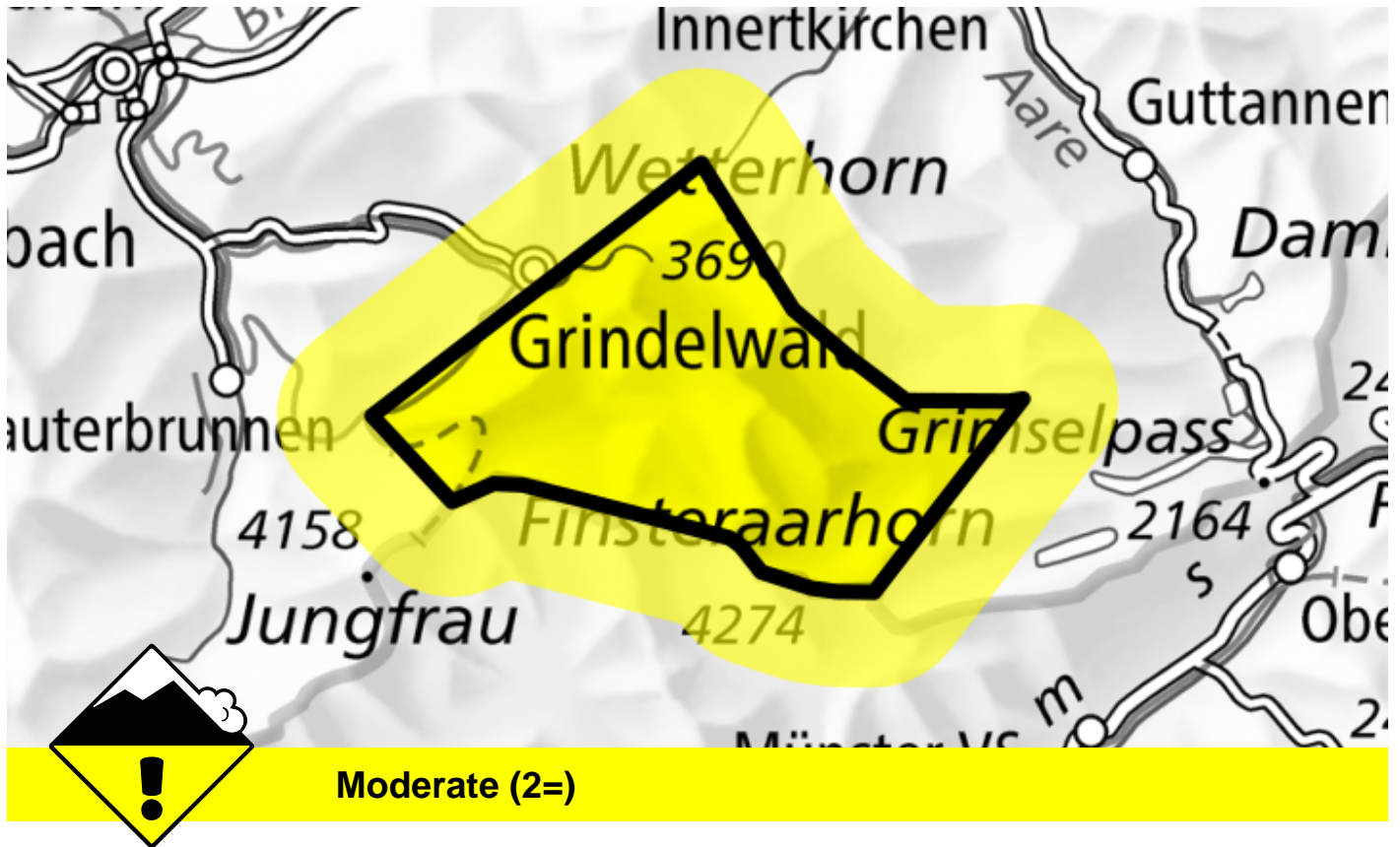


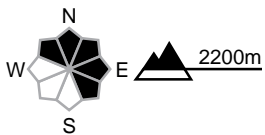
Avalanche danger

Avalanche prone locations Danger description




As a consequence of new snow and a sometimes moderate westerly wind, wind slabs formed on Tuesday especially adjacent to ridgelines and in gullies and bowls as well as in high Alpine regions. These are to be evaluated with care and prudence in steep terrain. The avalanches are rather small. Avalanches can additionally in very isolated cases be released in deeper layers above approximately 2800 m. Backcountry touring and other off-piste activities call for meticulous route selection.

The Avalanche Warning Service currently has only a small amount of information that has been collected in the field, so that the avalanche danger should be investigated especially thoroughly in the relevant locality.
