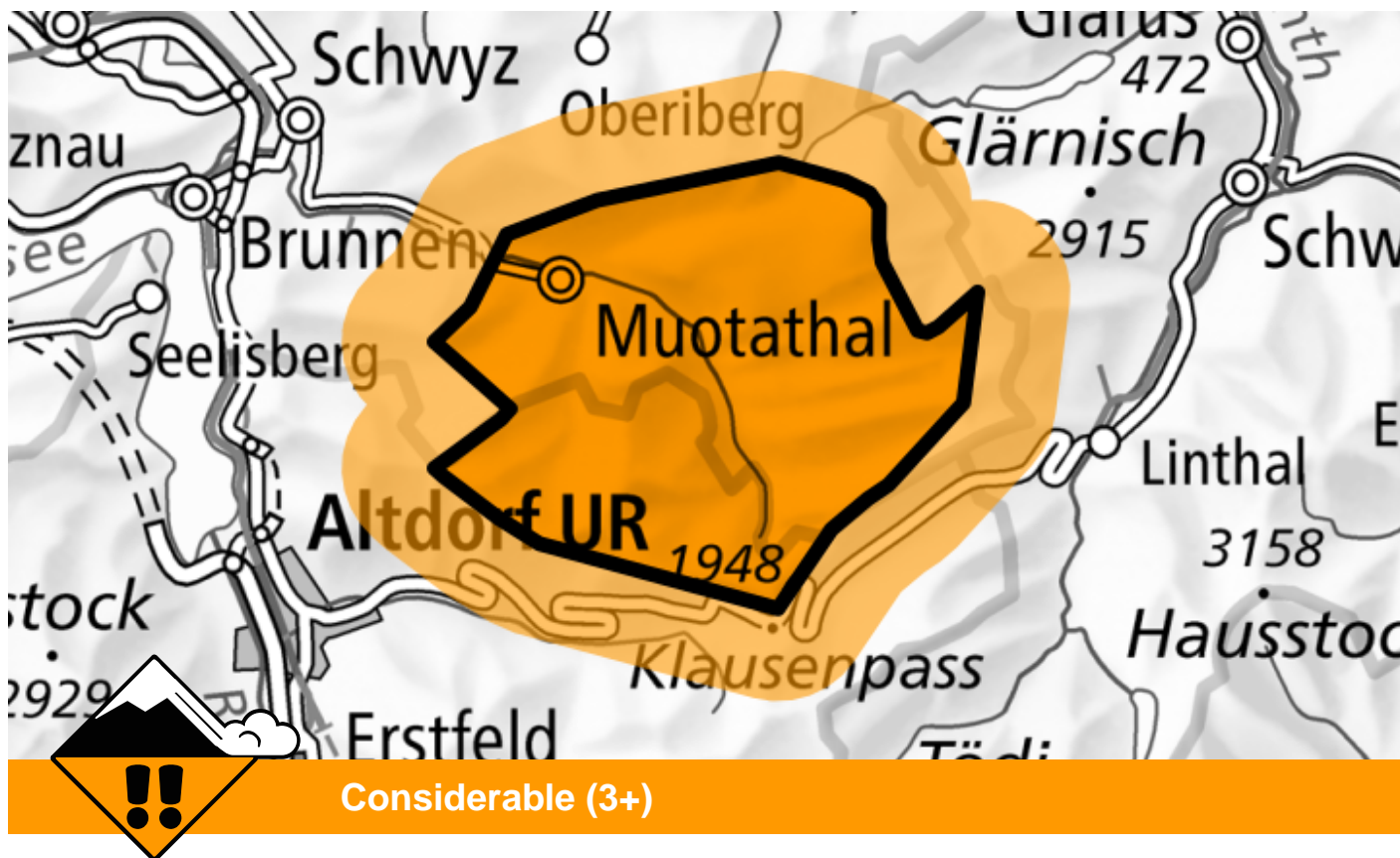


# Avalanche danger

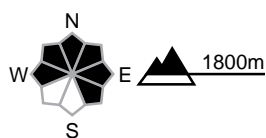

### Danger description



The new snow and wind slabs are prone to triggering. Avalanches can be released by a single winter sport participant. They can in some cases penetrate deep layers and reach large size.

As a consequence of new snow and stormy weather there will be an increase in the danger. More frequent natural avalanches are to be expected.

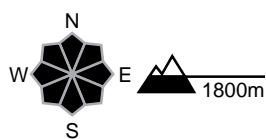
Backcountry touring calls for experience in the assessment of avalanche danger.

### Danger description



Wet snow slides and avalanches are to be expected as a consequence of the rain, in particular on very steep slopes. These can reach medium size. Apart from the danger of being buried, restraint should be exercised in particular in view of the danger of avalanches sweeping people along and giving rise to falls.
