

Avalanche danger

Wind slab, Persistent weak layers

Avalanche prone locations Danger description



The wind slabs of the last few days are lying on top of a weakly bonded old snowpack. Avalanches can in some places be released by a single winter sport participant. Small to medium-sized avalanches are possible. As a consequence of new snow and a strengthening northwesterly wind, further wind slabs will form in the course of the day. The number and size of avalanche prone locations will increase.

The wind slabs are clearly recognisable to the trained eye. Whumpfing sounds and the formation of shooting cracks when stepping on the snowpack can indicate the danger. Backcountry touring and other off-piste activities call for careful route selection.
