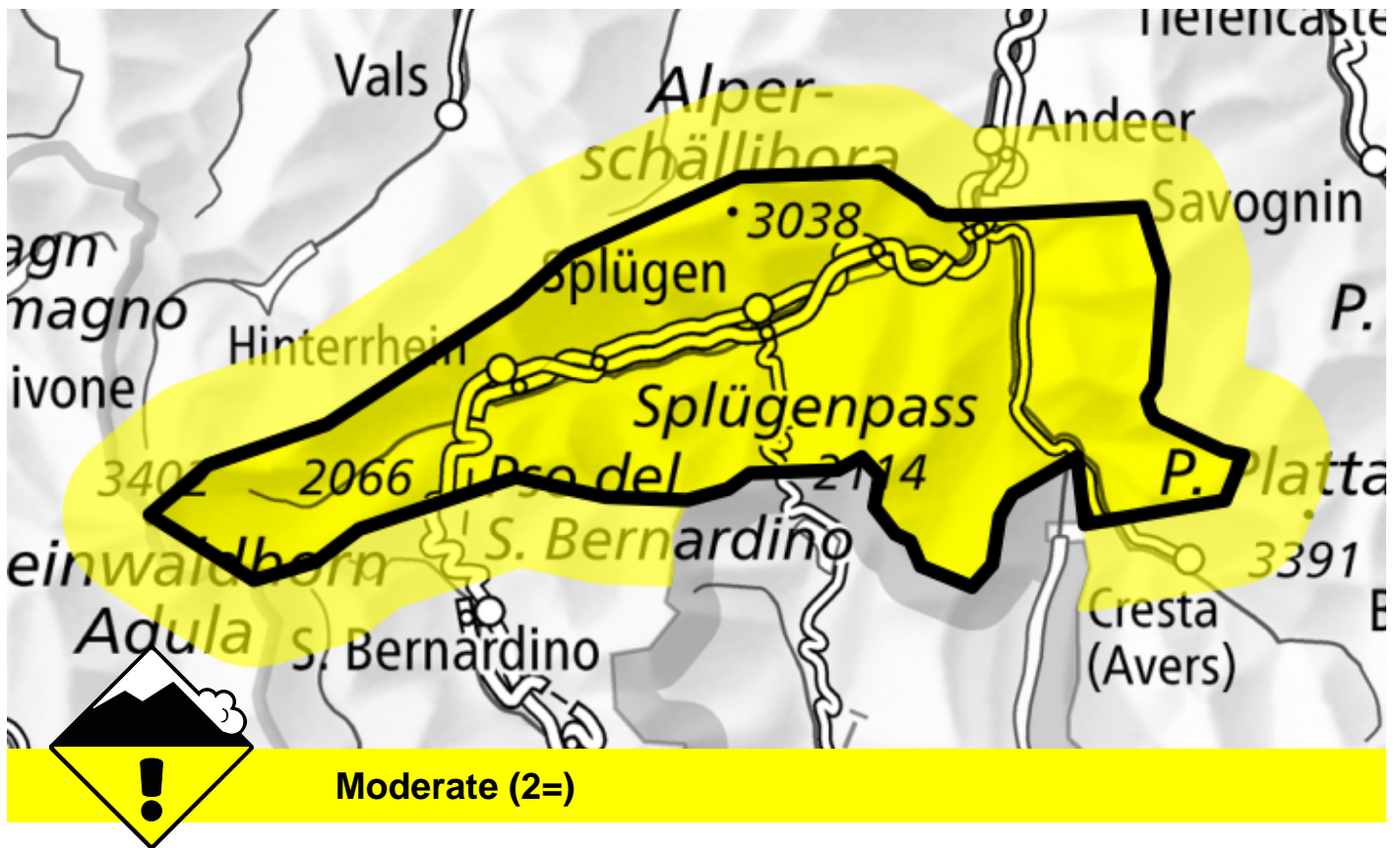


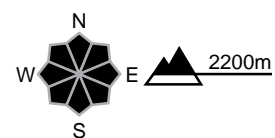
Avalanche danger

Wind slab, Persistent weak layers

Avalanche prone location



Danger description
Fresh and somewhat older wind slabs are in some cases still prone to triggering. These avalanche prone locations are to be found in particular adjacent to ridgelines and in gullies and bowls and generally at elevated altitudes. Additionally in isolated cases avalanches can also be released in the old snowpack and reach medium size. These avalanche prone locations are barely recognisable. Defensive route selection is appropriate.

On very steep grassy slopes more small to medium-sized gliding avalanches are possible.
